Those who went to Alencon and the Mayor's Reception will agree that in some small way we are returning the hospitality and strengthening the contacts made this year.

Diary of a Photography Trip

In early March I decided to treat myself to a few days of photography in the North East. I planned the trip based on the images and reports of fellow photographers. How ironic, then, that I soon found myself planning my days so as to avoid other photographers. Here's the story of my week...

Monday, pm. Arrive in Amble for my first night on the Northumberland coast, but it doesn't look very promising. Amble was recommended by Andy Jones. Hmm. Could it be that Andy misled me deliberately? Next time I take a decent coastal landscape shot I resolve to tell Andy that it was taken at Canvey Island.

Tuesday, am. Apologies to Andy. I eventually find the good bits in Amble.

Tuesday, pm. Inspired by a Joe Cornish picture that I had seen, I head for North Sunderland Point, near Seahouses. It's a grey, overcast day. I chat briefly to a chap who is strolling on the beach. He can tell I'm a photographer, and as he watches me wrestling with my new Benbo tripod, he says, "I do a bit of photography myself – but I don't bother when it's like this". Undeterred, I carry on until I find Joe Cornish's rocks. I'm very happy with the pictures I take. That Joe Cornish knows a thing or two!

Wednesday, am. The crack of dawn and I position myself on the beach looking towards the majestic Bam-

burgh Castle. A faint orange glow appears on the eastern horizon. Sipping from a steaming cup of coffee from my flask, I wait for the light to develop. This is all absolutely idyllic, until... another photographer emerges from the dunes behind me. Then another. Then two more. Eventually I'm sharing the beach with 15 photographers, each wielding a tripod plus an enormous gadget bag. I walk off in a huff, passing the two minibuses that brought all these unwelcome visitors to my beach. On the plus side, a few hundred yards away I discover a beautiful, quiet and unspoilt bay. Maybe I wouldn't have found this new location if it hadn't been for the arrival of all those other photographers.

Wednesday, pm. Drive down a narrow lane that will give excellent access to Embleton Bay. I feel certain that I've discovered a little-known track that will provide great views of Dunstanburgh Castle. I cannot believe it when I see the same two minibuses parked at the end of the lane. Sure enough, the beach at Embleton Bay is crawling with photographers. A feeling of paranoia starts to set in later that evening as, strolling from my guest house to the pub for dinner, I notice the minibuses are now parked outside the main hotel in Bamburgh. I try to think rationally about how best to avoid another encounter with these photographers at dawn tomorrow, quickly dismissing any thoughts of letting down their tyres.

Thursday, am. Gambled on going to

photograph Dunstanburgh Castle at dawn. The gamble pays off as I have the beach and castle all to myself. But for the umpteenth time (on this trip alone) I end up with wet feet. I wish I had listened to Stuart Boyd's tip about wearing wellies.

Thursday, pm. Mike Farrow had recommended a place called Spittal, just on the southern edge of Berwick upon Tweed. An unpromising name for a place, but the beach at Spittal boasts a rich collection of amazingly beautiful stripy rocks (if you like that sort of thing). And thankfully Spittal does not appear to be a popular place with other photographers.

Friday, am. One last sunrise before returning south. I decide to take a chance on Bamburgh Castle again. It's a cracking morning – the best so far – and I have it all to myself. I wonder where all the other photographers are this morning. Such a shame that they missed out!

I had a wonderful break in Northumberland. Before going I had read that it represented one of the great undiscovered corners of the British Isles, and my experiences confirmed that this was mostly true. But I also realised that the area contains a few "honey pots" that attract photographers in large numbers, even in mid-week in winter.

I am convinced that the more members are given the

chance to get to know each other, the more we will all benefit from our membership.

This brings me back to next year's programme. I would like to include two or three evenings when members show their work to the rest of us. This need not necessarily involve someone committing to presenting a whole evening. What I envisage is a couple of evenings when two, three or even four members give a short presentation of recent work, with a commentary on how they have gone about producing their images. It would be particularly pleasing if some of our newer members could do this.

I have already approached a few people, but if you think you could fill 15 minutes, half an evening, or even a whole evening, please don't wait for me to ask you, offer your services! On the other hand, if you see me coming your way with a smile on my face, don't run away!
